Brief description of ATM Schools

Advanced Training in Mathematics (ATM) Schools are a joint effort of a large number of mathematicians across the country, with support from the National Board for Higher Mathematics. The programmes are conducted in reputed mathematics institutions in the summer and winter every year. The emphasis in these Schools is on solving problems, and on the relations between basic areas of mathematics. The schools are intended mainly for Ph.D. students and lecturers. Applications are now invited for participation in the following school.

Instructional School for Teachers on Functional Analysis

This school is aimed at Lecturers in colleges and Universities who teach Analysis. Knowledge of several advanced topics in Functional Analysis is now a prerequisite for students intend to persue research in Analysis. We plan to cover, rapidly during the first week, basic Functional Analysis, theory of topological vector spaces and operator theory. The second week will be devoted to selected advanced topics from Geometry of Banach spaces, approximation theory, operator theory and operator algebras.

Eligibility for participation

Applications are invited from Lecturers in Mathematics who have passed NET / SET or equivalent examination and who are teaching at a college / university. Students doing M.Phil may also be considered for the school. Applicants below the age of 35 will be given preference.

Financial Support

Selected participants will be paid AC 3-tier return train fare from their place of work to the venue by the shortest route and will be provided with accommodation and local hospitality.
